

## Consumer Alert - EXTRA CHARGES CHARGED TO CREDIT CARD BY KUCHING HOTEL

I stayed at a HOTEL in Kuching on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2007 and checked out on the 17<sup>th</sup>.</font></p><p align="justify"><font face="Verdana" size="1">2. I settled the bill by credit card amounting to RM 333.50</font></p><p align="justify"><font face="Verdana" size="1">3. Today upon receiving my credit card statement I found out that I have been charged an additional RM 21 (Malaysia Ringgit Twenty One Only) without me signing any receipt.</font></p><p align="justify"><font face="Verdana" size="1">4. I faxed my CC statement to Josephine on 25.4.2007 and latter received a call from SHARIFAH. She said that the RM 21 were charged because I have taken a bottle of water from the minibar. According to her it was discovered after I have left the hotel.</font></p><p align="justify"><font face="Verdana" size="1">5. I did not take any items from the minibar during my stay and even if I have consumed anything I would have told your staff during my checkout. I am not that hard up for the water bottle.</font></p><p align="justify"><font face="Verdana" size="1">6. The reason I am writing this letter is to seek clarification on certain doubts:-</p><ul><li><div align="left">How could the hotel accuses a guest have taken certain things from the minibar after the guest has left the hotel. The house keeping team would have used it when they come to clean the room. If the hotel doesn't trust their guest then you should check the room when the guest is at the counter when checking out before he leaves the building.</div></li><li><div align="left">How could the hotel say for sure what is in the minibar before a guest goes into his room? There was no inventory taken with the present of the guest. Maybe the said water bottle was not even there when I went in?</div></li><li><div align="left">How could you charge my CC (additional RM 21) without me signing any receipt? It seems that there is an element of Criminal Breach of Trust and cheating when a customer uses his CC in this KUCHING Hotel.</div></li></ul><p><strong>7. APART FROM GETTING EXPLANATION ON THE ABOVE DOUBTS I AM DEMANDING THAT RM 21 THAT HAVE BEEN CHARGED TO MY CC UNLAWFULLY TO BE REFUNDED BACK TO ME BY this KUCHING Hotel.</strong></p><p align="justify">8. I have also stayed for the second time in your hotel on the 18<sup>th</sup> April 2007. Maybe this time it's the TV and BED?
