PUTRAJAYA: Toys containing lead and harmful to children will be banned. ♦

♦ We need to investigate and conduct a proper study before taking action on anyone. We cannot act based on media reports or else the wrong people will be penalised, ♦ said Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Minister Datuk Shafie Apdal

♦ He said several steps had been taken to ensure that toys not only met the standards set but were also safe for children. ♦

♦ If the toys have been proven unsafe, we should ban and take them out of the market, ♦ he told reporters after a Hari Raya celebration hosted by the ministry here. ♦

♦ The Malaysian Association of Standards Users has alleged that many children's toys sold in the market had high lead content which could cause brain damage and affect growth. ♦

♦ Asked whether his ministry had seized unsafe toys in the past, Shafie said: ♦ Actually, we have taken action numerous times but they were not reported. ♦ ♦

♦ Ministry enforcement chief Roslan Mahyuddin said a draft on the government standards on toys was ready in 2002 but had not been gazetted yet. ♦
